Work shoes or work boots will be required in class. Steel-toed is not necessary.

The waterstone is quite fragile – be careful with it. **Please buy a small Tupperware container with a lid to keep it submerged in water once classes begin.**

The tools in the upper list have been selected based on affordability and quality. I strongly advise against making any substitutions. Inferior tools lead to frustration and wasted time.

Tools in the lower list are not as critical and may already be in your possession

Concerning chisels: Stanley, Buck Brothers, Master Mechanic, Sears, etc, are not acceptable.

Try to find the specified combination square. Available through Amazon.com. Buy nothing with plastic parts.

DO NOT PURCHASE A COMBINATION SQUARE WITH ANY PLASTIC COMPONENTS.

Project Material Costs run approximately \$75 - \$125 first semester; \$75-\$300 second semester depending on material and design options that the student selects. The students keep their projects.
