<u>Accommodations</u>	<u>Available</u>	<u>Who is Responsible</u>	<u>How delivered</u>
1) Extended Test Time	Yes	Student initiated	Instructor, Coordinator, Tutor Must be scheduled in advance
2) Review, Drill, Repetition	Yes	Students time	Tutoring, Additional study time
3) Books on Tape	Maybe	Student initiated	Use of Computer aids such as Kurtzweil Reader, or application or Books on Tape through Recordings for the Blind, Scan to Read Software- student purchased.
5) Lecture Notes	Yes	Student initiated	Instructor or assigned Peer
6) Adapted Curriculum	No	Student	Student is expected to be able to be able to handle the academic level required for college work.
7) Extended time for Assignments	Maybe	Student time	Deadlines are generally held to; Students use their time to complete work.
8) Reduced course load	Yes	Student	Additional cost to student via extended time in college
9) Course substitution	Maybe	Student initiated	Permitted only if course is not essential to program of study -College decides
10) Tape recorded lectures	Yes	Student	Student provides equipment Instructor may provide notes instead

<u>Accommodations</u>	<u>Available</u>	<u>Who is Responsible</u>	<u>How delivered</u>
11) Calculator	Yes	Student	Student provides not permitted in for Fundamental and Basic concepts
12) Auditory or Vision Adaptation	Yes	Student	Student provides,
13) Test aids such as word banks, open book tests, re-testing, telling the student what to study for tests	Maybe	Student	Instructors may provide tests for all students in one of these formats. Student is expected to know the material.
14) Oral Testing, Scribe for Tests	Yes	Student initiated	Scheduled in advance with Special Needs Coordinator-tests are not re-worded or explained.

***IMPORTANT NOTES:**

IEP DOES NOT transfer from high school to college

College provides **REASONABLE** accommodations

STUDENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE for their education,

Parents **DO NOT** have direct contact with instructors, but may contact counselors.

Students who are taking medication to control behavior or emotional problems must take responsibility for their medication.

STUDENTS MAY CHOOSE TO NOT DISCLOSE THEIR DISABILITY,

and parents cannot disclose for their student. If the student changes his or her mind the request is **NOT RETROACTIVE**.

ATTENDANCE IS CRITICAL- Health conditions, medical appointments that take a student away from classes where ability to perform or class participation is a part of the grade may not be excused.

Recommendations for Success in College: Proficient PSSA Scores; Reading ability at 10th grade or higher; Exposure to Algebra, Computer Literacy; Motivation to study
